THE BOARD TO REVIEW AND CONSIDER AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF A FIVE-YEAR NOTE FOR PANOCHE DRAINAGE DISTRICT TO PAY BACK PANOCHE WATER DISTRICT FOR FUNDING OF EXPENSES FOR THE SJRIP AND GRASSLAND BASIN DRAINER ACTIVITIES FROM 2019 THROUGH 2020 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,433,041.53

Mr. Hurley reviewed the drainage district expenses that were paid for by Panoche Water District from 2019 and 2020. At this time, the drainage district was experiencing cash flow issues and needed assistance from Panoche Water District. These expenses have been booked by the Drainage District auditor and are expected to be paid. Mr. Hurley reviewed the breakdown of the \$1,433,041.53 and explored various methods of repayment to the Water District. President Barcellos reminded the board members that there needs to be a clear delineation between the Drainage District and the Water District and that any future "transfers" of cash between the two entities need to be approved at the board level and not done by staff. President Barcellos would like staff to develop a policy on how this financial partnership could be developed through clear and concise protocols. After discussion amongst the directors and staff, President Barcellos tabled this item until a future meeting. Mr. Hurley stated that he would have it back on the agenda at the October 2023 meeting.

GRASSLAND BASIN AUTHORITY

- There has been an increased effort to manage the weed issue in the drains.

Mr. Hurley is continuing to vet? the advantages of annexing the property owned by the Nelson family along the southern edge of CCID's Main Canal. He has talked with the Nelson family and expects to set up a face-to-face meeting with them in late August or early September. Mr. Hurey reminded the board that there is a complete review of this item in their action item list that was sent out earlier.

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
